- Reception for former Dons and Doñas to introduce the museum expansion
- Secured an architect, Lauterbach & Associates as well as other consultants
- Board member and General Contractor, Bob Fierro, has provided invaluable assistance to get the projects nearly ready for permits
- Conducted soil samples and seismic drilling study
- Obtained City Conditional Use Permit (CUP)
- Met city requirements for expansion...architectural plans for exterior/interior, landscaping plans, etc.
